## Course Selection Guidance System for Students in the Department of Chemical Engineering

- **Article 1** The course selection guidance system for students of all levels in the Department of Chemical Engineering is implemented in accordance with the university and departmental course selection regulations.
- Article 2 For undergraduate students, course selection guidance is primarily provided by class advisors, who assist and oversee students' course selection matters. Students may consult their advisors about course-related issues before registration. After the add/drop period, the Office of Academic Affairs will issue the course selection list, which must be signed by the advisor to complete the course selection process. The department office prepares a graduation requirement checklist for each freshman, which is provided to the advisor. The advisor retains this checklist until the student graduates and ensures accurate verification and guidance each semester.
- Article 3 For graduate students, the Office of Academic Affairs, Graduate Studies Division, issues course selection lists to the students. The students' respective advisors assist with guidance and confirm the course selection by signing the lists.
- **Article 4** This system shall be announced and implemented upon approval by the Departmental Meeting.
