Undergraduate Incentive Guidelines for Pursuing Graduate Studies

October 29, 2009 Proposed and approved in the College Academic Committee meeting March 5, 2010 Revised and approved in the College Academic Committee meeting (regarding the name of the regulations and Articles 1, 3, 4, and 5)

- **Article 1** These guidelines are established to encourage undergraduate students with outstanding academic performance at this university to pursue master's or doctoral programs in the College of Engineering.
- **Article 2** Funding Sources: Administrative management fees of the college or other related funds.

Article 3 Eligibility for the Incentive:

- I. Undergraduate students of this university who are admitted to the college's graduate programs through the departmental graduate entrance examination and whose ranking, as stated in the certification of their examination results, is within the top 30% of their class.
- II. Undergraduate students of this university who are directly pursuing a doctoral degree.

Article 4 Incentive Method:

Each awardee will receive a subsidy covering the base tuition and fees for the first academic year. Each department or graduate program may award up to three students per year.

Article 5 Application and Review Process:

Applications shall be submitted according to the timeline announced by the college. Each department or graduate program will forward eligible candidates for review by the college in accordance with these guidelines.

Article 6 These guidelines shall be announced and implemented upon approval by the College Academic Committee.
