- **Article 1**: Graduation requirements mandate that required credits must primarily be earned through courses offered by the department. The department reserves the right to review and determine the equivalency of courses. Students must comply with these regulations to avoid any impact on their rights or interests.
- Article 2: For retaking or summer retaking of general required professional courses, students must prioritize enrolling in required courses offered by the department. Retaking or summer retaking courses from other departments (including those from other universities) is permissible only after completing a credit recognition form and obtaining approval. The credits will only be recognized upon approval. (The credit recognition form must be prepared in duplicate, with one copy retained by the student and the other by the department office.)
- **Article 3**: For retaking or summer retaking of general required professional courses from other departments (including other universities), the course title, credit hours, and syllabus must align with the department's required courses. Approval will be granted only after review by the course instructor or the Curriculum Committee Chair and confirmation by the Department Chair. Otherwise, the credits will not be recognized.
- **Article 4:** The prerequisite courses for required courses are based on the following table. Only those who meet these requirements may enroll in the listed required courses. If a student has not completed the prerequisite courses, the instructor may decide whether to allow them to enroll in the required course.
- **Article 5**: If the semester grade for a required elective course is below 30, the course must be retaken.
