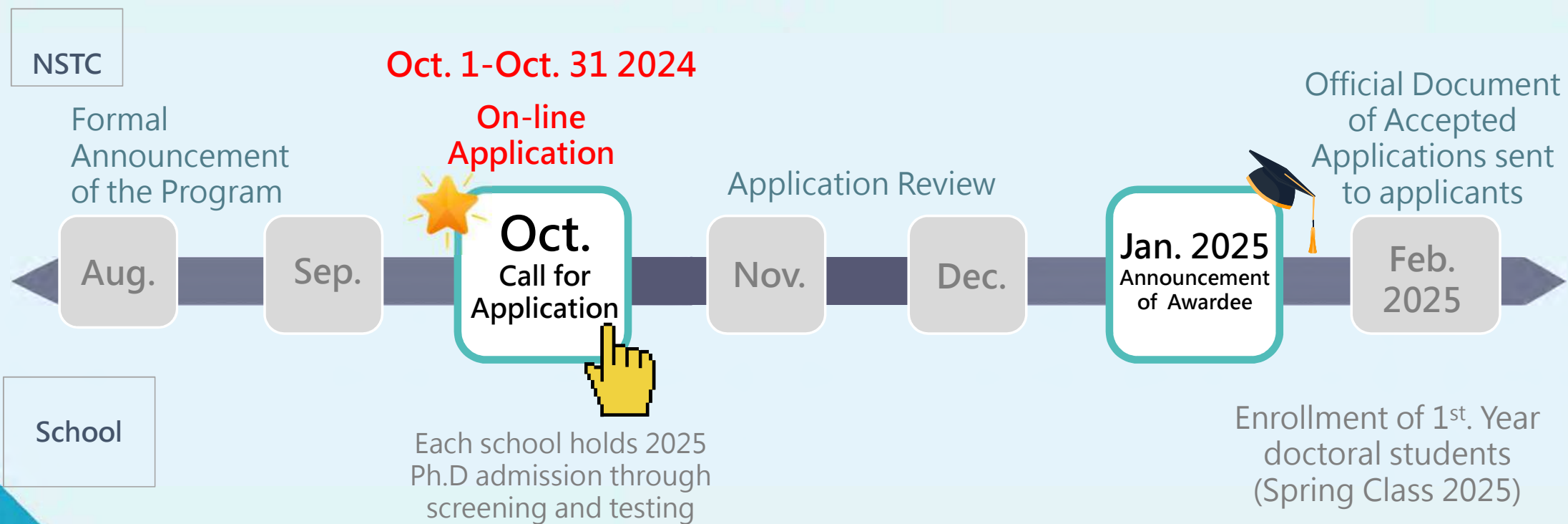

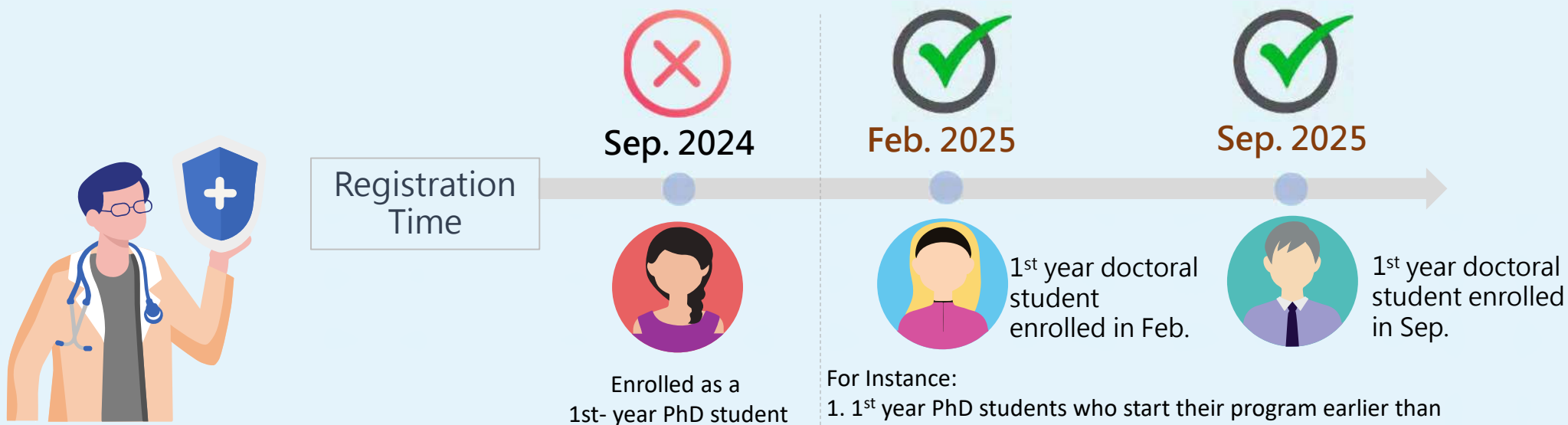

Q&A 1: Eligible Recipients

Recipients : 1st- year doctoral students enrolled either in Feb. or Sep. 2025



For Instance:

1. 1st year PhD students who start their program earlier than expected.
2. 1st year doctoral students who directly study the PhD program.
3. Overseas 1st year doctoral students of the Spring Class.

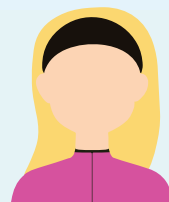

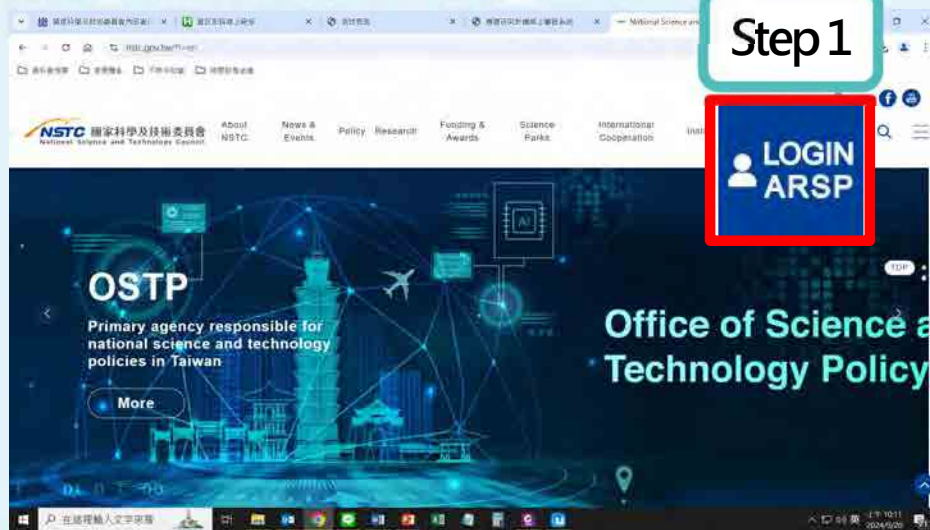
